



Supporting the Free Rivers Fund

Thanks for your interest in supporting the Free Rivers Fund! This info sheet provides general information on who can support, the benefits and how it works.

Who can support?

Everyone who likes to support the fight for free flowing rivers can donate money to the Free Rivers Fund (FRF). For companies the donation will be tax deductible. We want to make it possible for any company to partner up with the FRF, no matter their size. So we introduced a low registration fee of 200€ that should be paid in the beginning of the year. Beyond this, companies are welcome to donate any amount, all year round. For individuals and clubs there is no compulsory minimum, any donation helps!

What are the benefits for companies?

Partnering with FRF gives companies an easy possibility to engage in the protection of free flowing rivers. Once a company has registered with FRF it is welcome to use the logo on its web page, in print media or by placing a banner at events to promote its engagement. Free Rivers Fund will publish all supporting companies on its website. Companies will receive an invoice over the total amount donated so that it will be tax deductible as advertising expenses. We want all partnering companies to benefit from supporting FRF. So if you have a vision of how supporting Free Rivers Fund would be best for your business, get in touch! You could for example donate a percentage of sales of a certain product, give a few cents per kilometer paddled and create an event around it, design and sell a shirt... feel free!

How to become partner?

Once you have decided to become our partner: let us know! Together we can work out which way of supporting is best for your company.

If you transfer the registration fee and then spread the Free Rivers Fund logo via your media: that's great! If you wish to do more than that, tell us so we can invoice the correct amount. After transferring the registration fee, feel free to spread the word!

When to donate?

Any time you like! Paying the registration fee in the beginning of a year is greatly appreciated though. It ensures that you can make use of the Free Rivers Fund logo all year long and helps us to estimate incoming donations and plan ahead. Further donations can be made any time you like.

Who receives funding?

Free Rivers Fund aims at helping small local grassroots initiatives. Any individual that sees his or her home river in danger and wants to become active can apply for a grant. The application procedure is easy so it does not take time that should rather be spend on action. Registered non-profit NGOs are welcome to apply, but it is not necessary to be registered as such.
